Dear Resident,

Circle C Paving will be performing a chip seal project in your neighborhood on behalf of the city. Chip Seal is completed by evenly distributing a thin layer of asphalt emulsion onto the pavement and then embedding finely graded aggregate into it. Clean up sweeping will follow the operation 1-2 days later. A fog seal will be applied at a later date and you will be notified again before that process.

Work is expected to begin on \_\_\_\_\_ and end on \_\_\_\_\_. No vehicles will be allowed to be parked on the street and access will be limited during this time. Vehicles parked on the street will be towed to nearby streets where there is no construction taking place. Residents who have questions or need special accommodations may contact the Contractor at the number provided below prior to the work's scheduled start.

During these dates, all cars need to be moved from the street by 7:30am, all sprinklers must not be run, and the street should be kept free of debris. The chip seal will be postponed by rain until the first day of dry weather.

#### Traffic and Driveway Access:

You will be able to keep your vehicle in your drive during this time. You will be able to come and go to your residence as needed as long as there is no equipment on your street. If there is equipment on your street, we will make every effort to get you to and from your residence during the construction period. During the 2-to-3-day period your street will be affected for a short amount of time by the seal process or the post sweeping process. S

Street access will be limited during the day. There will be access at all times for emergency vehicles. Parking in your driveway is recommended. If you walk or drive through the oil that does not have aggregate on it YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE for any damages to your vehicle or property.
