To: Residents adjacent to the Avenue "A" Street Project
RE: Closure of Avenue "A"

We regret to inform you that Avenue A will remain closed to thru traffic. Our hope was to have Avenue "A" open for the Christmas holiday, but unavoidable delays made it impossible. However, we will be able to allow local access to homes along the project. We ask that you do not park on Avenue "A".

Barricades will be staggered on Cottonwood, Sycamore, Tulip and Fisher Streets to allow residents access to their properties.

Only minimum work will continue from now until January 3rd. Avenue "A" may be closed again for a short period of time in order to complete cleanup and re-seeding. We are confident Avenue "A" will be open to thru traffic by the second week in January. When weather permits, Avenue "A" will be closed to complete Phase II of the project which continues East to the railroad tracks.
